THE MARY LEONORA FOUNDATION

The Mary Leonora Foundation is a charitable organization that supports Catholic education in Pakistan. Its president is Thomas DeSouza, whose wife, Rita DeSouza, is one of QART's regular members.

The Mary Leonora Foundation is experiencing challenging times in its support of 6 Catholic schools in Faisalabad, Pakistan. Because of COVID-19, the Pakistan government forced the closure of these schools for the greater part of the past year and prevented the Catholic school board from collecting school fees. The result was that 75 teachers were shorted a total of 294 months of salary.

The Mary Leonora Foundation is now trying to help the

Catholic school board find the \$21,000 needed to pay its teachers. The Foundation has asked QART for any help that QART could provide. In response, QART donated \$100 to the Foundation on your behalf.
